

Instructions for use

Swab

Intended Use:

Intended to be used to apply medications to, or to take specimens from, a patient.

Intended User:

Intended to be used by Healthcare Professionals on patients that require application of medications or specimen collection.

Precautions:

- This device is single use only. Reuse of this device may lead to cross contamination and/or device failure
- Do not re-sterilize.
- Do not use if product or package is damaged.
- Do not use for purposes other than intended use.
- During use, avoid excessive force or strain on the swab in order to preserve device integrity.
- Do not use if bud end of swab contacts anything other than intended medication/specimen site.
- Specimens collected from a patient or areas where medication is applied can contain infectious substances. Seek proper training and instruction on facility protocols before applying medication or collecting/ handling specimen.
- The use of this swab for any specific medication application or testing procedures should be validated by the user.
- Device is in intended for limited contact duration, less than 24 hours.

Instructions for Use:

- 1. Don appropriate personal protective equipment per facility protocols.
- 2. Peel open sterile pouch.
- 3. Remove swab from package, without touching bud end of swab.
- 4. Use swab to apply medication or collect specimen from patient. Ensure bud end only touches area of medication application or specimen collection.
- 5. If applicable, process the swab following the procedure required for the specimen being collected.
- 6. Dispose of contaminated devices per facility protocol and all applicable federal, state, regional, and/or local laws and regulations.
